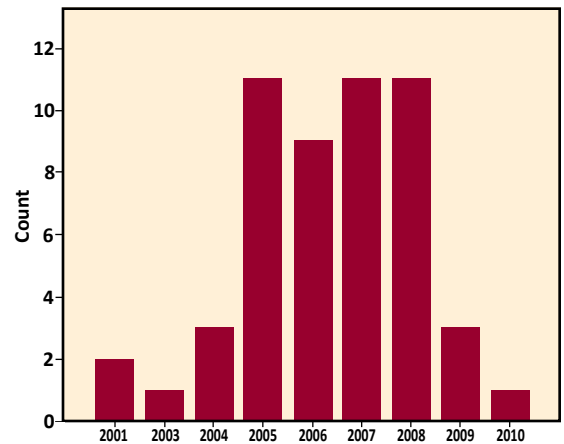
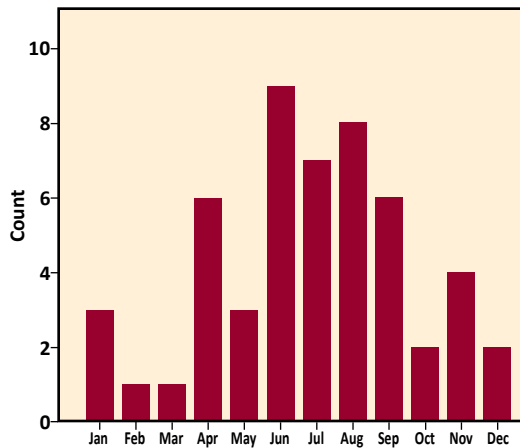
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Background

This survey was administered to focus group participants in May and June, 2010. The goal of the survey is to capture economic, social, and demographic characteristics of residents who have moved into the region. There were seven sessions held across seven communities of west central Minnesota: Appleton, Canby, Dawson, Granite Falls, Madison, Montevideo, and Ortonville. This data was collected to be used by a coalition of development organizations in the region as a part of a Regional Recruitment project. A total of 61 surveys were completed, of which seven are excluded from the analysis as they were identified as intra-regional migrants. One additional survey was excluded as the respondent moved to the region fifteen years ago. The total sample size analyzed for this report is 53.

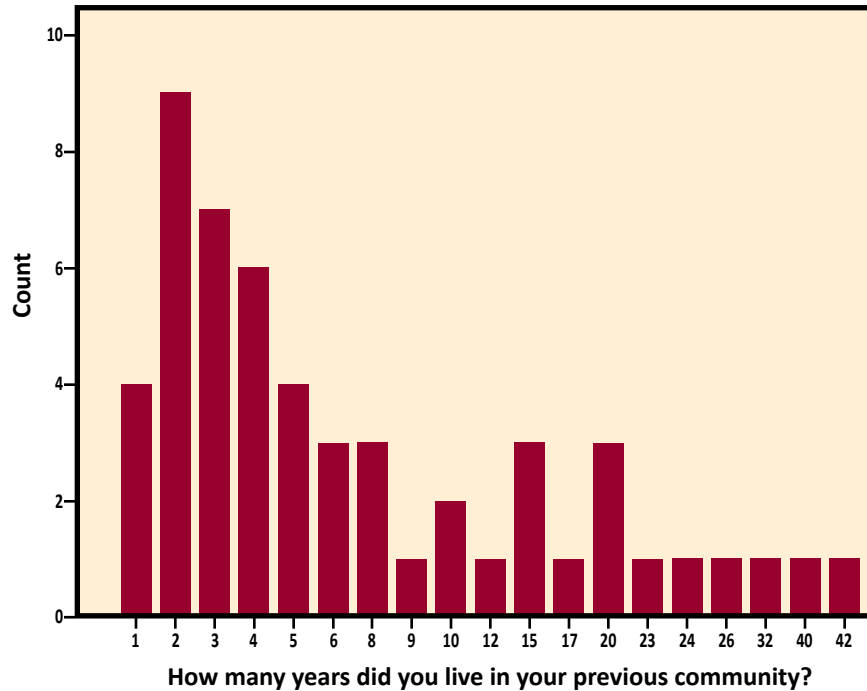

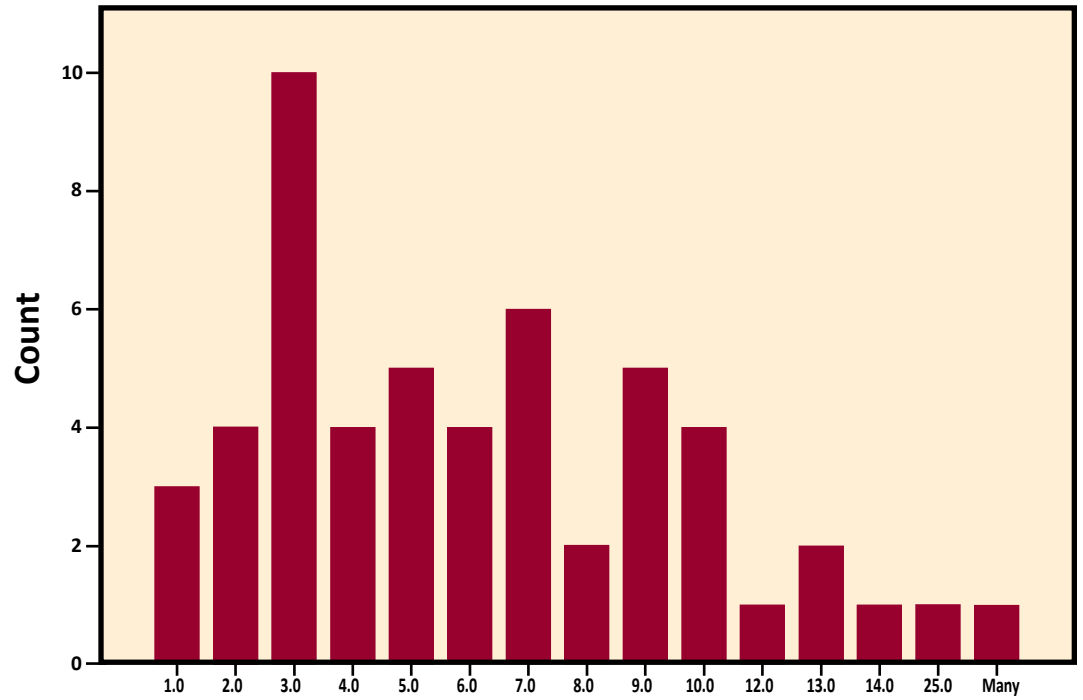

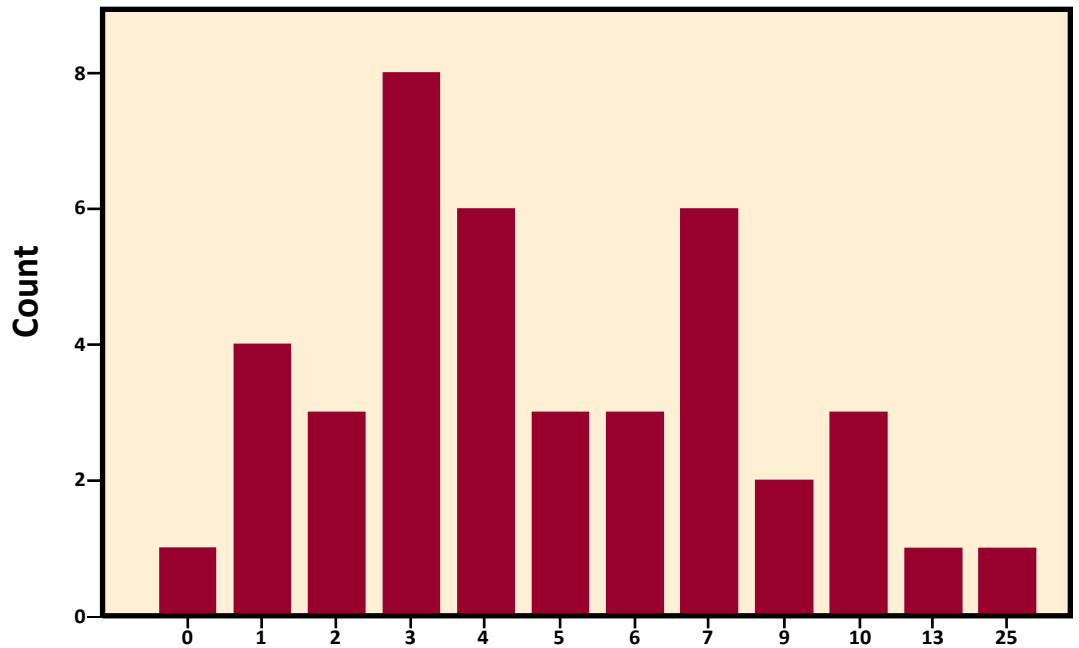

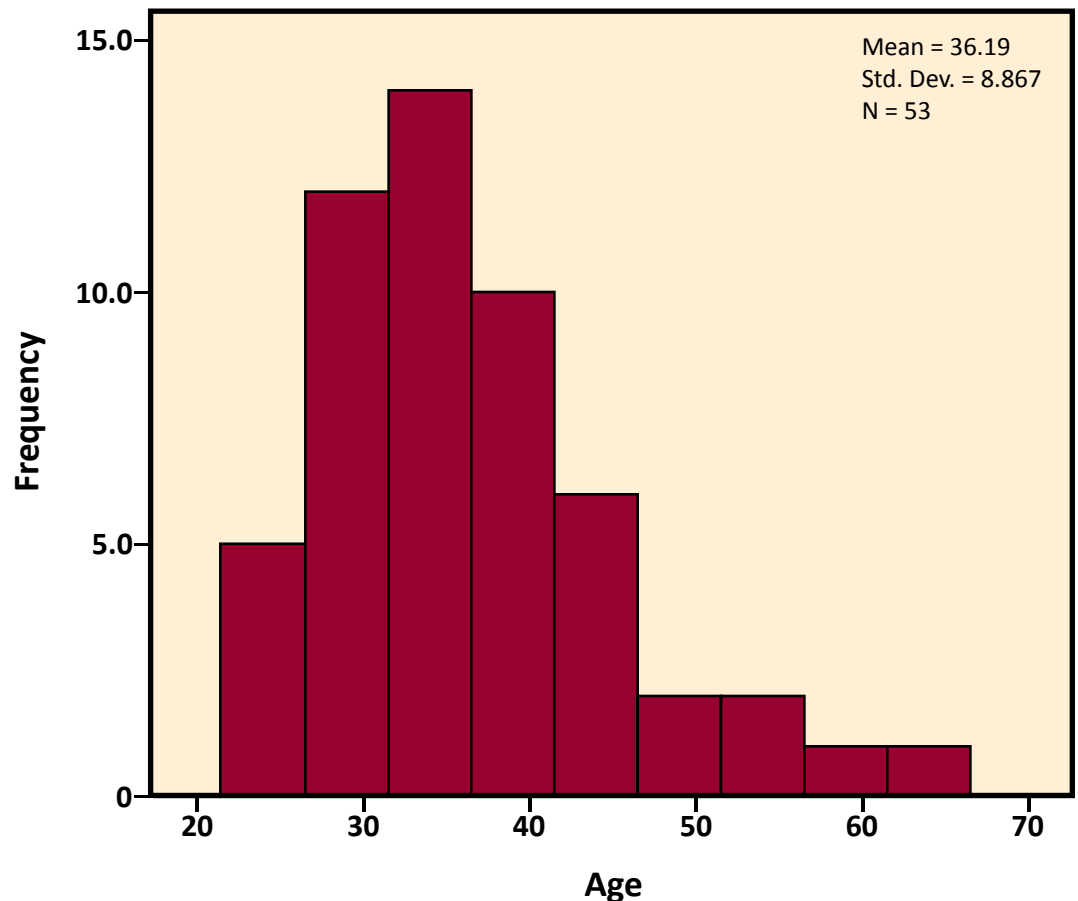

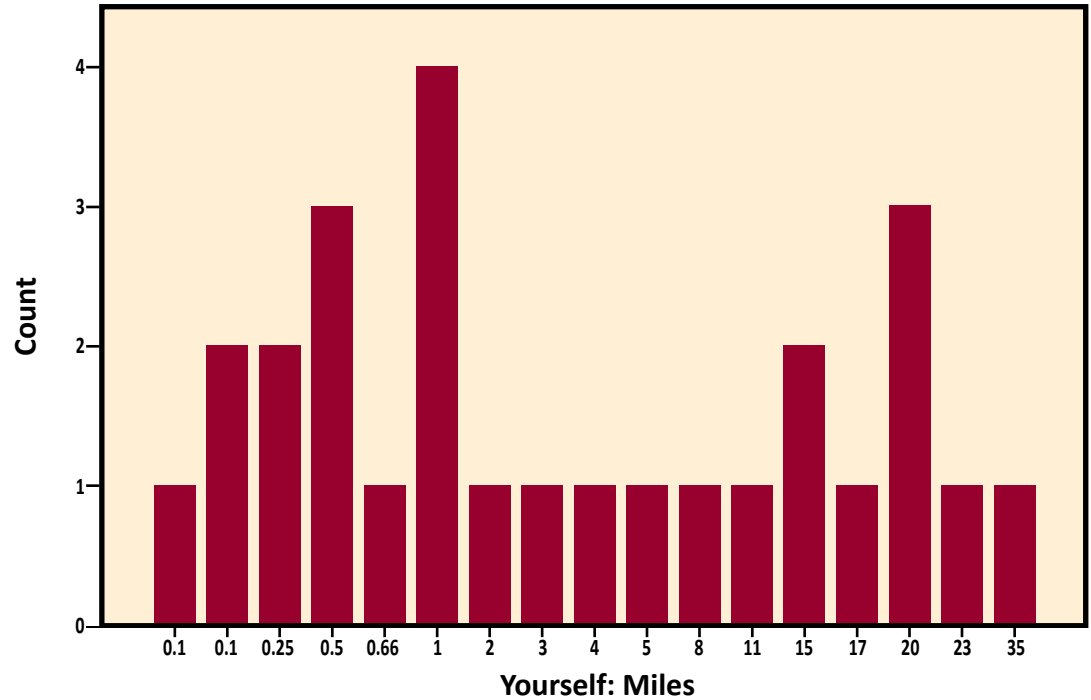
